RE: ADMISSION & JOINING INSTRUCTIONS FOR NEW STUDENTS ACADEMIC YEAR 2025/2026

Congratulations for being among the candidates selected to join	at
Jordan University College (JUCo) for the academic year 2025/2026. This is ayear (s) programm	ıe.

The registration processes will commence on 3rd to 9th November,2025. There will also be a week of orientation obligatory for new students from the same dates (3rd to 9th November 2025). Therefore, all students should report to the College from 3rd November 2025, and lectures will commence on 10th November 2025.

During registration, candidates should fulfill the following conditions:

- 1. You are required to come with original birth and academic certificates ("O" Level, "A" level certificate and transcript for Diploma, Bachelor or Masters). Result slips for those who completed "O" level and "A" level in 2025.
- 2. Residence Permit or Exemption Certificate for Non-Tanzanians.
- 3. Payment of tuition fees, either in full or installment (s) as shown in the payment schedule. All payments are non-refundable.
- 4. A duly filled medical examination form from a recognized hospital by the government (forms are to be downloaded from our website www.juco.ac.tz)
- 5. One passport size which is recently taken.
- 6. Payments for Tuition fees should be made through CRDB, NMB, M-Pesa, Airtel Money, or MIXX BY YAS (Tigo Pesa) via each student's control number created by the students themselves in their JUCO SIMS accounts(www.sims.ac.tz).
- 7. Payments for accommodation can be made either in full or in two installments through each student's accommodation control number created by the students themselves in their JUCO SIMS accounts(www.sims.ac.tz).
- 8. Please note that, penalty of 50,000 TZS will be charged for any late registration and 25,000 TZS for Late payment of other installments. The deadline for registration is 1st December, 2025.
- 9. Students should have a valid/active Health Insurance Policy from the National Health Insurance Fund (NHIF), AAR, NSSF, STRATEGIES, or other recognized health insurance providers. For the NHIF health insurance, the arrangement will be made with the NHIF office to enable them to get it at the college. The cost for Tanzanian students (Both Degree and Non-degree) is 50,400 TZS, while for foreign and postgraduate students, it is 192,000 TZS.

NB: Those who will fail to adhere to any of the above directives shall not be registered.

ACCOMMODATION

The university has adequate accommodation facilities for both male and female. Priority will be given to students with physical disabilities. Payments for accommodation can be made in full or into two installments through each student's control number after obtaining INVOICE NUMBER from JUCO - SIMS Account. All payments are non-refundable. ACADEMICS

Consistency and self-discipline will be required for you to succeed in your studies. General
academic performance will also be evaluated, usually at the end of each semester. Behave in a

For men indecent dressing includes short trousers above the knees, trousers hanging under the buttocks, very tight trousers and unbuttoned shirts are also not tolerated.
